### Bargaining Update: June 25 and 26

On June 25 and June 26, ETFO met with representatives from the Ontario Public School Boards' Association (OPSBA), the Council of Trustees' Associations (CTA) and the government.

Discussions on June 25 were focussed on the process of developing the list of items for the ETFO **Teacher/Occasional Teacher central list**. On June 26, discussions took place around the process of developing the list of items for the ETFO **Education Worker central list**.

Progress was slow on both days, but we are starting to see some movement. So far, discussions with representatives of the Crown, OPSBA and CTA have been respectful.

ETFO will be meeting with government and school board representatives to continue talks around the development of the central lists on:

- **Monday, July 15 (Education Worker); and**
- **Tuesday, July 16 (Teacher/Occasional Teacher).**

On July 17, members will receive an *ETFO Collective Bargaining eNewsletter* from the provincial office that will include an update about these meetings.

### Bargaining Updates in July and August
