All personal vehicles will be asked to park at the Western Fair Farmers' Market at

the corner of Dundas Street & Ontario Street.

When? Sunday, July 21, 2024, beginning at 12:00 noon, leaving from Quebec St. (between

Dundas St. and Dufferin St.) and heading down Queen St.

From Queen St., the parade will turn right onto Colborne St., left onto Dufferin St., then right onto Clarence St., ending at Clarence St. and Angel St. by Victoria Park.
