Violence in Schools

In the 2023-2024 school year there were 5366 reported incidents of violence directed towards staff, for an average of 537 per month, or 28.8 per day.

The elimination of violence is elementary schools remains a top priority of the ETFO Thames Teacher Local.

We continue to call for an anti-violence action plan, and that determined steps be taken to address disruptive student conduct to make schools safe and peaceful for all.

Teachers are reminded that the **Communication Protocol** remains in effect, **from** Friday, September 20 at 6:00 p.m. **until** Sunday, September 22 at 6:00 p.m.

The Board's **Disconnecting from Work Employee Procedure** came into effect on Thursday, June 2 in compliance with the **Working for Workers Act, 2021**.

Violations of the **Communication Protocol** and the **TVDSB Disconnecting from Work Procedure** must be reported to the Local office immediately.

- Defend the Collective Agreement and the rights of Teachers under it.
- Ensure that the provisions of the Occupational Health and Safety Act are enforced.
- Bring to the attention of TVDSB ongoing Teacher concerns, with the expectation that these concerns will be taken seriously and resolved quickly.
