**Workplace Violence** as defined by the OHSA:

 the exercise of physical force or an attempt at physical force that causes or could cause injury to a worker

#### **OR**

 a statement or behaviour that is reasonable for a worker to interpret as a threat to use physical force that could cause injury to a worker

## SSIR forms

suspension or expulsion

must be considered are

at the top of EIRIF and

Part One - EIRIF

- Complete the form on eBase when there has been injury to a worker, or the potential for injury has occurred
- the form will be submitted to your immediate supervisor through eBase

### Part One - SSIR

- Complete the form on eBase when there has been an incident involving student behaviour by a student or between students
- The form will be submitted to your immediate supervisor through eBase

### **Part One**

 Complete the Health and Safety Concern Form, with assistance from your site health and safety representative if necessary



# Part Two Health and Safety Concern Form Supervisor Response

 Will include any preventative or corrective measures to mitigate risk

### Part Two – EIRIF Administrator Response

- Will be emailed to the worker within 24 hours, and should include a link to the investigation
- The response will include measures to prevent recurrence

### Part Three – EIRIF Worker Response

 If worker feels their safety is still at risk and has not been resolved at the site level, please contact the Local.

### Part Two – SSIR Administrator Response

- Will be emailed to the worker within 72 hours indicating Action Taken or No Action Required
- Action Taken references if suspension or expulsion occurred, not if an investigation occurred or if measures were put in place

## Part Three Health and Safety Concern Form Worker Response

- Indicate if health and safety concern has been resolved at the site level
- For unresolved issues/forms please contact the Local Health and Safety officer for discussion/resolution

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
