Landmark Decision on Violence

Accompanying this update is a link to a communiqué from the New Brunswick Teachers' Federation (NBTF) regarding a landmark decision pertaining to violence in schools. The upshot is that the employer's obligation to provide inclusive education to students does not outweigh the employer's duty to ensure a safe, violence-free workplace to employees.

While this adjudication does not have direct application in Ontario, it is very helpful in addressing issues of violence in our elementary schools.

Teachers are reminded that the **Communication Protocol** remains in effect, **from** Friday, November 1 at 6:00 p.m. **until** Sunday, November 3 at 6:00 p.m.

The Board's **Disconnecting from Work Employee Procedure** came into effect on Thursday, June 2 in compliance with the **Working for Workers Act, 2021**.

Violations of the **Communication Protocol** and the **TVDSB Disconnecting from Work Procedure** must be reported to the Local office immediately.

Duty of the Local

- Defend the Collective Agreement and the rights of Teachers under it.
- Ensure that the provisions of the Occupational Health and Safety Act are enforced.
- Bring to the attention of TVDSB ongoing Teacher concerns, with the expectation that these concerns will be taken seriously and resolved quickly.
- · Communicate with Teachers in a clear, concise, and timely manner
