Regarding:	Progress in International Reading Literacy Study (PIRLS)

Dear Presidents,

The Progress in International Reading Literacy Study (PIRLS) is an international assessment administered every five years that measures trends in students' reading-literacy achievement for grade 4 students and is organized by the Council of Ministers of Education, Canada (CMEC). The last assessment was in 2021, and the next assessment will be in 2026.

A field test of PIRLS 2026 will be administered between March 10 and April 18, 2025, with grade 4 students at randomly selected schools in Ontario. The administration will be supported by EQAO.

If a teacher's classroom has been chosen to participate, it is the professional responsibility of that teacher to administer the PIRLS assessment. Like EQAO, the PIRLS teacher questionnaire is voluntary.
