Doug Ford says smile and be happy, the pandemic is over. At the same time, Ontario is now firmly in the midst of a sixth wave, there are estimated to be up to 120,000 new Covid-19 cases daily, BA2 is establishing itself as the dominant variant, and BA5 is now established in South Africa. We may feel that we are done with COVID but COVID is not yet done with us.

Against this backdrop, TVDSB Trustee Corinne Rahman brought forward a motion that would have reinstated masking requirements for students and staff in all TVDSB schools and worksites. Trustee Rahman spoke eloquently to the motion, which ultimately was struck down on technicalities.

And so, we find ourselves in a muddle created, with deliberate political purpose, by the Ford Conservative government.

Some members of the rank and file want ETFO to stop talking about anything related to the pandemic. Other members of the rank and file want ETFO to issue a directive regarding masking we cannot issue, and then enforce that directive with authority we do not have.

Throughout the pandemic ETFO has advised that Teachers should follow the advice of public health. Given the government's removal of most public health protections regarding COVID-19, the advice from the Chief Medical Officer of Health and Local Medical Officers of Health is to strongly encourage the wearing of masks when in indoor settings, like schools. ETFO TVTL strongly encourages Teachers to follow the advice of the Chief Medical Officer of Health and Medical Officers of Health by wearing masks when in indoor settings, like schools.

The combined effects of increasing absences due to illness caused by COVID, and an ongoing crisis of unfilled vacancies, are taking a severe toll on Teachers, compromising the delivery of program, destabilizing schools, and making them unsafe places for students and staff alike.

We continue to fight the good fight to uphold the Collective Agreement and the integrity of the terms and conditions contained within it. We are ready to mobilize Members in anticipation of the looming provincial election. We remain hopeful that better days are ahead.

Please note that TVDSB Trustees voted on Tuesday April 19 to reinstate mask requirements, in all schools and worksites, for all staff and students.

FIRST VICE PRESIDENT'S REPORT - Michael Thomas

1.0 Federation Annual Meeting

• From August 17-19, the Executive attended ETFO's Virtual AGM (or FAM). This summer, ETFO Thames Valley was represented virtually by our Delegation at the Annual Meeting in Toronto. We continued to advocate for the working conditions of our Members and discussed important issues. While it was a virtual meeting, we were able to discuss some issues relating to Health and Safety, the mental well-being of ETFO Members, and the ETFO Budget, however, the majority of the meeting was monopolized by individuals from other Locals wanting their own agenda items discussed. The meeting also saw the election of a new ETFO President, Karen Brown.

2.0 Health and Safety

ETFO Local Health and Safety Committee Meeting: September 2021

- Our ETFO Local Standing Committee met and examined the Terms of Reference for the
 committee, the Duties of the Standing Committees, as well as discussing issues within
 schools. COVID-19 became a main focus of our Local Standing Committee and we will
 be discussing the safety protocols and procedures to ensure to advocate for the safety
 of workers within the schools. This has certainly created challenges for Members, and
 we will continue to monitor and advocate as things evolve.

Joint Health and Safety Committee Meeting: September 2021

 Discussions on the following: Hepafilters and its function/usage, Cohorting of students and placement with classrooms, Violence Reporting System; School Closures, Training for Committee Members, PPE, and Enhanced Cleaning Measures.

ETFO Local Health and Safety Committee Meeting: October 2021

• Working to address the serious increase of violence throughout the schools. With students being back in school full-time now, the Board has had an increase in Accident/Incident Forms that have T10. We are working with the Board to address these concerns. The first step is ensuring the Board acknowledges that there is a serious issue within the Board. We are in discussion with the Board to ensure that documentation is properly filled out so that we have baseline data to examine the problem in its entirety. We are also examining the Management of Aggressive Behaviour Policy to ensure that the safety plan focuses on worker safety also. In addition, there is a lack of EA supports throughout the system, which is making safety plans obsolete, so we will be seeking to address this concern. The Emergency Codes within schools is another area of concern, as they are inconsistently utilized, so we need to ensure that they are understood and accurately utilized.

Joint Health and Safety Committee Meeting: October 2021

• Discussion in regards to monitoring the Board Reports and asking that they be sent out earlier.

ETFO Local Health and Safety Committee Meeting: November 2021

- Currently, there are nine locations within the Board that are being utilized for vaccine distribution. The Board is discussing with the Public Health Units to ensure that worksites are safe and comply with Board Protocols and Policy.
- There are many ventilation systems within the Board that require filters to be changed. The Board is examining filter specifications and is writing a work instruction to ensure that there is some consistency within the filters in the ventilation systems. Hopefully, there will be a program developed soon to address the filters.
- Enhanced Cleaning: The Ministry of Labour and the TVDSB met to discuss the order.
 The order was re-examined and determined that it was complete. The TVDSB and the
 Board are not moving along with the appeal. Both sides decided that the order met the
 needs. The Ministry of Labour spoke to the issue, and the fact that COVID is now
 airborne, the cleaning isn't as much of an issue in terms of surface contact. As there
 are cases, the site is isolated until disinfected. The Ministry agreed that this was
 sufficient.
- There are currently three different type of rapid test kits being utilized within TVDSB, but it is not Board driven but Board co-operative. The Ministry of Education and Health have indicated that all schools have them. There are 5 locations with the Rapid PCR test kits available which was implemented by Ministry of Education and Health Unit. The Board is ensuring that there are sufficient kits at school to be sent home (not rapid PCR but they are getting the antigen kits) for students to utilize over the holidays. This is currently being arranged.

Joint Health and Safety Committee Meeting: November 2021

- Recommendation to review Emergency procedures has been approved by the Board and there will be three meetings in 2022 of a Sub-Committee.
- Discussion around increase in T10 reports and the need for a Board response when multiple reports are filed from one site.

ETFO Local Health and Safety Committee Meeting: December 2021

- JHSC Member Training Concerns around the process of recertification, the need for one-day recertification when requested and that training is scheduled to be in-person in January were discussed. Inquiries about what up-grading training is available for those with non-expiring certification. To be discussed at next JHSC Meeting.
- Safe School Forms Safe Schools Forms should be submitted according to the Safe Schools Act. JHSC looks at incident reports to highlight problem areas. Historic concern to have proper documentation submitted.
- Revisit of MOL to Wilfrid Jury P.S. Ministry of Labour (MOL) revisited Wilfrid Jury P.S. and acknowledged there was no definition for the term 'frequently' in previous report. MOL satisfied with combination of current cleaning schedule and availability of cleaning supplies for staff.
- Harsh Cleaning Chemicals Cleaning chemicals have caused rashes and reactions to skin. Concerns regarding storage of cleaning materials in classrooms were raised. Information will be requested at JHSC Meeting.
- Inconsistent Following of Protocols Reports made that there is inconsistent following of protocols among schools. Will request at JHSC Meeting that a reminder memo is sent in the new year.

Joint Health and Safety Committee Meeting: January 2022

COVID Protocols

• All locations should have been sent the non-fit N95 masks already, focusing on Special Education classes, and then all locations. Training program was sent out for input from the Joint Health and Safety Committee and then sent out to Employees so that they can understand N95 mask usage. The PPE Protocol has been updated to include the N95 masks. The TVDSB is awaiting more shipments from procurement (via the Provincial government). The Board is expecting a small surplus so that there will be enough available. Employees can use either N95 or medical masks. The Board only got 1/5 of the order of the N95s from the government, making it challenging to get these masks out to schools.

Ventilation System Updates

 Additional HEPA units are coming into the schools (79-81), prioritizing within the Special Education classrooms. Trying to ensure that they are being distributed throughout the system.

Enhanced Cleaning

 Current process is being followed. Able to maintain current protocol cleaning, especially with students not being in schools.

Omicron Variant

Examining isolations and notifications to schools. Public Health is treating everyone
based on symptoms, not testing. Positive rapid test might need to be followed up by
formal testing. Will the Board still be contacting parents/staff if a child is sick? No. Public
Health is not contact tracing and will not be notifying families/schools, as they state that
since parameters are in place (masking, hand washing, social distancing), that students
aren't considered close contact.

PCR Rapid Test Updates

• Some staff and most students received them prior to the Break. There aren't sufficient tests throughout the Province so there might not be any more tests any time soon.

Screening Requirements

• Employees will have to screen daily. Students are strongly encouraged to screen every day, but this can't be enforced.

February 2022 – Health and Safety Highlights

Vaccine Clinics

• There are 6 being held in in the Middlesex London unit, after-hours. Must pre-register and the information goes out to the community. Southwest Public Health – focus is on students only. There were two last week and it seemed to go really well. They are focusing on areas that have low vaccine numbers. The clinics start throughout the day and are not open to the public. They will not vaccinate a student without the parent being present which has created a challenge. They have to screen the parents and make sure the parent is masked. Parent access in the building is controlled.

Protocols

 Number 7 and 2a have been updated. Number 7 gets updated regularly and the information is updated on Sharepoint.

Ministry of Labour Visits and Orders

Some of the visits are based on Occupational Illness (COVID) from December. A couple
of critical injuries investigated. Worker Complaint from Saunders: usage of students
using bandanas/face coverings. Ministry of Labour stated that it isn't sufficient so
workers must wear medical grade mask/non-fit N95 and safety goggles (like unmasked
child).

Ventilation System Update

- a) Filter Changes: Completed the preventative maintenance. Occupational Health examined it. Plan should be put into place in the next couple of days. Filters are checked every month and changed every three months unless visibly needing it.
- b) **HEPA Filters:** Frequency changes depends on each model. Preventative maintenance schedule speaks to this. On track to be compliant with manufacturing specs for filter changing/cleaning.

Rapid Testing

Rapid test kits were sent home with students. The Board is finalizing plans for what to
do with the extra because as it stands, there is no plan for more to be sent to the school
Boards from the Government.

Tracking of Cases

- No updating going on with notification of cases in a school location. Once at 30%, a letter is dispersed to the community to provide notice, not closure; 30% could be absences on attendance, not necessarily due to COVID.
- On Provincial Government school site, all schools are listed with absence rates. A letter
 gets sent out, explaining masking, vaccination, etc. The number of staff and students is
 total absences (any unplanned). Planned absences are not recorded.

ETFO Local Health and Safety Committee Meeting: March 2022

- As we have seen over the past few months, violence is on the rise again within our schools. As we are trying to advocate for more progressive discipline and behavioural supports throughout the system, it is important that Members continue to complete the appropriate paperwork that identifies concerns. In addition to the Employee Accident/Injury Form and the Safe School Reporting Forms that are filled out, two forms that are crucial to identifying violence within the school are the Notification of Potential Risk of Injury Form and the Risk Assessment. These forms are rarely utilized throughout the school Board.
- For any incident of violence or potential violence, there needs to be a risk assessment done. The results of the assessment determine what measures and procedures need to be put in place to prevent physical injury. This leads to the workplace safety plan or crisis response plans. There should be continual reassessments to the risk of workplace violence as often as is necessary to protect workers from potential injury.
- The second form, the Notification of Potential Risk of Injury should be filled out for any
 worker who might come into contact with a student with violent tendencies. We are
 working with the Board to have them create a truncated safety plan that has enough
 information to keep the worker safe, such as triggers, mitigating factors, potential risk to
 the worker, and how to get immediate support.
- Although every Administrator is different in the manner in which they address student behaviours, we need to ensure that every precaution has been taken to ensure our safety. We need to collectively ensure that student aggression and violence is addressed, so please keep us informed whenever there are situations that are not being appropriately supported at the school level.

Mutual Concerns Health and Safety Meeting: April 2022

- Discussed the need for the Board to start addressing Violence within the schools. There seems to be a lot of work needed to ensure that the appropriate Employee Accident/Incident Forms, the Violent Incident Forms, and the Safe School Report Forms are filled out for each incident. The Board has started producing monthly data to examine violence with the schools, however, there are significant gaps in schools that are reporting incidences. We stressed to the Board that we need to reconvene the Violence in the Workplace Sub-Committee, as every time it is scheduled, it is cancelled. We suggested that this needs to be a standing committee, meeting regularly, with actionable results. We await the notification for the meeting at this time.
- Also discussed the Notification of Potential Risk of Injury Forms and the Risk Assessment Forms and stressed that the Board needs to ensure that every worker that could potentially come in contact with violence be notified. Workers are rarely notified.

Joint Health and Safety Committee Meeting: April 2022

 Discussed the monthly data gathered that seeks to document violence in the schools, however, there are significant gaps in schools that are reporting incidences. As we continue to address the issue of violence with the TVDSB, we need to ensure not only that it is documented appropriately, but that when incidences occur, they are investigated to ensure that appropriate supports are put into place to prevent future occurrences.
