- demonstrates a keen interest in all health and safety issues affecting Teachers;
- exhibits an awareness and understanding of local and provincial issues;
- has a history of ETFO Thames Valley Teacher Local involvement;
- conduct themselves in a professional matter; and
- demonstrate confidentiality and collegiality.

LOCAL HONORARY LIFE MEMBERSHIP AWARD

The nominees for Local Honorary Life Membership will have given outstanding service to the Local through involvement on committees, Executive or professional development. Nominees must be retired at the time of the nomination.

PRESIDENT'S AWARD

The nominee should be an active ETFO Thames Valley Teacher Local Member, who has served the Federation in various and significant leadership roles either locally or provincially, and has brought credit to the teaching profession through their ongoing accomplishments.

WORKPLACE STEWARDS' AWARD
