Posting of Asynchronous Activities

Teachers will use professional judgement when posting independent asynchronous activities that support the continuity of program and student learning to classroom digital platforms.

Students who are registered in Short-Term Virtual Learning (STVL) may access these activities; however, they will receive any needed support from LSS Staff who are offering Office Hours. Activities completed by STVL students will not be submitted for evaluation.

Students who are registered in In-Person Learning may access these activities during absences and will have the opportunity to submit these activities for consideration and feedback.

LSS Support for Short-Term Virtual Learning

Students registered in STVL will have access to independent activities in their classroom's digital platform, Ministry-approved resources, and Week-at-a-Glance activities. Questions about any of the work students are completing are to be directed to LSS Staff offering Office Hours.
