Violence and Harassment Against Educators



Disability matters!

Violence and harassment should not be "part of the job," but, far too often, education sector workers are told it is.

A 2018 survey of Ontario elementary school educators found that in one year:

- 54% experienced one or more acts of physical violence,
- 72% experienced one or more incidents of harassment, and
- 47% did not report their worst incident of workplace violence.

BUT not everyone has the same experiences...

Educators who identified as disabled experienced:

- More frequent and more repetitive harassment from students and from administrators,
- Twice as many instances of harassment from parents,
- Three times more frequent instances of harassment from colleagues, and
- More reprisals for reporting harassment or violence.
