Violence and Harassment Against Educators



Gender matters because...

- Education is a women-dominated field,
- Women educators have unique experiences in the workplace, and
- Women navigate elevated rates of sexual harassment.

A review of WSIB claims found that the risk of workplace violence among women educators increased fivefold between 2009 and 2015.*

Our previous research found that education

sector workers who identify as women:

- Experienced more harassment from parents
- Were more than twice as likely to experience familial impacts as a result of workplace violence
- Reported higher levels of workplace burnout and more symptoms of PTSD
