Regarding: Professional Judgement and Progress Reports

The following statement is embedded in the Collective Agreement:

Professional Judgement shall be defined as judgement that is informed by professional knowledge of curriculum expectations, context, evidence of learning, methods of instruction and assessment, and the criteria and standards that indicate success in student learning. In professional practice, judgement involves a purposeful and systematic thinking process that evolves in terms of accuracy and insight with ongoing reflections and self-corrections.

Teachers will input the following information onto the Elementary Progress Report Card:

- Ratings in each "Learning Skills" and "Work Habits" Section.
- Ratings for "Subjects" Section that are applicable.

Consistent with Growing Success, Teachers will use their professional judgement to determine what learning skills, work habits, and subjects they comment on in the "Strengths/Next Steps for Improvement" Comment Boxes.

- Progress Report Cards for students in Grades 1-8 are due into the report card system by the end of the instructional day on Thursday, October 27.
- Progress Report Cards will be returned to Teachers by Monday, November 7
- Progress Report Cards will be sent home on Friday, November 11.
- Teachers will make corrections for spelling, grammar, and punctuation only.
