The central tentative agreement town hall meeting is scheduled for Monday, December 11 from 6:30-7:30 p.m. Login information will be sent to all Teachers on Monday afternoon.

### Local Collective Bargaining

Local collective bargaining resumed on Wednesday, December 6 and Thursday, December 7. Five more local collective bargaining dates have been confirmed for January, February, and March. The ETFO Thames Valley Local Bargaining News will be sent to all Teachers on Monday, December 11.

### Violent Incidents

In November there were 692 reported violent incidents in schools, 580 of which involved physical contact.

#### **Communication Protocol**

Teachers are reminded that the **Communication Protocol** remains in effect, **from** Friday, December 8 at 6:00 p.m. **until** Sunday, December 10 at 6:00 p.m.

The Board's **Disconnecting from Work Employee Procedure** came into effect on Thursday, June 2 in compliance with the **Working for Workers Act, 2021**.

Violations of the **Communication Protocol** and the **TVDSB Disconnecting from Work Procedure** must be reported to the Local office immediately.
