Current Collective Agreement language, provisions, and past practices are subject to a statutory freeze during the period of central and local collective bargaining bargaining (Labour Relations Act, 1995, Section 86, Subsection 1).

Violations of the collective agreement <u>must</u> be reported immediately to the ETFO Local office (519-474-3150).

Local Bargaining

The tentative agreement between the Thames Valley District School Board and the ETFO Thames Valley Teacher Local has been ratified by both parties.

Teachers voted 98.9% in favour of acceptance.

The next step is to work on the timely application of the Kaplan salary arbitration award.

Teachers are reminded that the **Communication Protocol** remains in effect, **from** Friday, June 14 at 6:00 p.m. **until** Sunday, June 16 at 6:00 p.m.

The Board's **Disconnecting from Work Employee Procedure** came into effect on Thursday, June 2 in compliance with the **Working for Workers Act, 2021**.

Violations of the **Communication Protocol** and the **TVDSB Disconnecting from Work Procedure** must be reported to the Local office immediately.

Duty of the Local

- Defend the Collective Agreement and the rights of Teachers under it.
- Ensure that the provisions of the Occupational Health and Safety Act are enforced.
- Bring to the attention of TVDSB ongoing Teacher concerns, with the expectation that these concerns will be taken seriously and resolved quickly.
- Communicate with Teachers in a clear, concise, and timely manner
