Current Collective Agreement language, provisions, and past practices are subject to a statutory freeze during the period of central and local collective bargaining bargaining **(Labour Relations Act, 1995, Section 86, Subsection 1)**. Violations of the collective agreement <u>must</u> be reported immediately to the ETFO Local office (519-474-3150).

## Local Collective Bargaining Update

The Local Collective Bargaining Committee met on September 13.

Local collective bargaining resumes on October 5.

The Table Team will bargain hard and in good faith, and it is the expectation of ETFO TVTL that the Board will do the same.

The Local will keep Teachers informed regarding progress at the local bargaining table in a clear, concise and timely manner.

The goal of the ETFO Thames Valley Teacher Local is to negotiate a fair collective agreement, that addresses working condition issues, through free local collective bargaining.

All Teachers are reminded of the following:

- Please update your Local and Provincial Member Profiles.
- Reorganization Staffing end shortly. In-School Staffing Committees should be meeting to review timetables, supervision schedules, and preparation time allocations.
- The deadline for notification of performance appraisal is October 10, as per **Collective Agreement** Article L5.05 (h), Evaluations.
- Collective Agreement Article L18.00, Medical Procedures Students prohibits Teachers from administering medication or performing any medical or physical procedure on any pupil that might in any way endanger the safety of the pupil or subject the Teacher to the risk of injury or liability for negligence. Sabrina's Law indemnifies Teachers regarding the use of EpiPens.

The Board's **Disconnecting from Work Employee Procedure** came into effect on Thursday, June 2 in compliance with the **Working for Workers Act, 2021**.

Violations of the **Communication Protocol** and the **TVDSB Disconnecting from Work Procedure** must be reported to the Local office immediately.

### Duty of the Local

- Defend the **Collective Agreement** and the rights of Teachers under it.
- Ensure that the provisions of the Occupational Health and Safety Act are enforced.
- Bring to the attention of TVDSB ongoing Teacher concerns, with the expectation that these concerns will be taken seriously and resolved quickly.
- Communicate with Teachers in a clear, concise, and timely manner.
